<b>Description:</b>	The vines are 80 years and the AOC was founded in 1937. Brouilly is, because of its storage (2-4 years), a powerful wine with rich tannins. The finesse of his flavours are developed after the first year by which his elegance charms the pallet. This wine should be drunk slightly cool.
